General Practice Information

Our goal is to provide excellent care for patients of all ages with the following problems:

- Asthma and other breathing disorders, such as bronchitis
- Seasonal and perennial allergies, such as hay fever and allergies to animals
- Skin allergies, such as hives or eczema
- Serious allergic reactions (anaphylaxis) to foods, drugs, or bee stings.
- Sensitivity disorders to cold, heat, skin pressure, or exercise

We hope to uncover the cause(s) of your problem(s) and outline a disease management program that will include avoidance recommendations, education about how to monitor your symptoms, medications and possible allergy vaccines, and ongoing follow-up care. **We request that you have a primary care doctor, as we do not hospitalize patients. If you have an acute medical emergency that cannot wait, please call your primary care doctor or 911.**

We can refill prescriptions by phone or fax during regular working hours, 8:30 AM to 5 PM Monday through Friday. Routine refill requests received during weekday evenings and weekends cannot be refilled until the next working day. **We may request that you be seen in the office before we refill your medication.** Asthma patients must be seen every 6 months and all other patients must be seen once a year to make sure the prescribed medication is still appropriate.

All minors (18 years and under) must be accompanied by their legal guardian for all appointments unless prior arrangements have been made. If parent attendance is not possible, a written statement from the parent must be submitted for each appointment stating that the child may be treated by our staff in any manner that we see medically necessary.

We look forward to participating in your health care.
